Hey, did you know?

- ♥ 18 days from conception, heart begins to beat, with the baby's own blood.
- ♥ At 9 weeks after conception, all essential organs have begun to perform.
- ♥ At 11 weeks, a preborn child is breathing amniotic fluid steadily and will do so until birth.
- ♥ At 12 weeks, a preborn child can kick, turn over, make a fist, and open his/her mouth.
- ♥ At 13 weeks, a preborn child's vocal cords and auditory senses are present.
- ♥ At 20 weeks, a preborn child can be startled by a loud external noise.
- ♥ At 23 weeks, a preborn child can demonstrate rapid eye movements (REM).
- ♥ At 6 months, fine hair grown on the baby's head and eyebrows and small eyelashes begin to appear.
- ♥ At 7 months, a preborn child's hands can support his entire weight.
- ♥ At 8 months, a preborn child weighs more than four pounds.
- ♥ During the 9 months from conception, a preborn child gains half a pound per week. Of the 45 total generations of cell replication that will occur by mature adulthood, 41 have already taken place.
- ♥ During pregnancy, if a mother suffers organ damage, the baby in the womb sends stem cells to repair the damaged organ. These stem cells can remain in the mother for many years after the birth.
