

THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER



Dear Friends of Life.

Often on the sidewalk or in other discussion forums, we lovers of Life are accused of ignoring the needs of Foster Children. My friend Greg, who is my sidewalk prayer partner, researched this issue and came up with the excellent article below. Of course we encourage adoption! And I know many of you have fostered in the past or currently foster children. Thank you, Greg!

Greg: Lately I have been seeing frequent posts by the Pro-Choice community claiming that since there are 400,000 plus children in foster care, that Pro-lifers really don't care about children after they are born. Nothing could be further from the truth. Pro-Life people around the country support the thousands of Pregnancy Resource Centers, Parenting Centers, Food Pantries, Foster Families, etc. They support them with hundreds of millions of dollars plus untold volunteer hours. But I will address that in a different post.

This post is about the foster care system itself. First off, there were approximately 437,000 children in the system in 2018. Of those, approximately 250,000 were processed in or out of the system. How can that be? That doesn't fit the narrative of the ProChoice mantra. Because each year, about 50% of children in foster care are reunited with their families. Additionally, the goal for 2018 was that 27% of the 437,000 would be adopted. The result at the end of the year was 25%, so they only missed the goal by 2%. The foster care system very nearly reached their goal, but that doesn't mean those in the 2% didn't get adopted, just not that year. The remaining ~25% fell in to categories of living with other relatives, guardianship or emancipation (aging out of the system). But that doesn't fit the narrative either.

You see, the long term goal of the foster care system is to reunite families if possible. But that is never told in the Pro-Choice narrative. Most parents that have their kids in foster care, want them back. Sometimes, even parents that want their kids back will never get them.

Those are some that spend the longest time in foster care because the parents are unwilling to surrender parental rights. So now you know that 75% of those 437,000 will NEVER be eligible for adoption. And almost all of the children eligible for adoption each year, do in fact get adopted. Pretty much deflates the Pro-Choice narrative doesn't it?

So how long does the average child spend in foster care? Most people watch too much tv and think that once a child enters foster care, they are in it for the rest of their childhood. The truth is the median length of stay is 14.7 months. So now maybe you can see the fallacy in the Pro-Choice crowd crying about children not getting adopted. You can't just put kids up for adoption against the will of the parents.


Then there are the ages of the children. The median age of children entering foster care is 6.1 years old. Babies make up a very small number of children in the foster care system, babies that become eligible for adoption are even fewer. The median age of children exiting the system is 7.5 years old. This doesn't support the Pro-Choice narrative for abortion since the vast majority of children lived with their parents for many years prior to whatever circumstances

- 34 percent in care for 1 to 11 months
- 30 percent in care for 12 to 23 months
- 15 percent in care for 24 to 35 months
- 10 percent in care for 3 to 4 years

resulted in them going into foster care. But hey, it is so much easier to make a meme and tell the lie that Pro-Lifers don't care about babies after they are born. Except one other little thing. Many, many pro-life supporters are foster parents and many are also adoptive parents!
